SISD reiterates rules at games, events

The Slaton Independent School District is reminding people of the policies in place for sporting events to ensure everyone is safe on and off the field.

Head Coach Lawrence Johnson wanted to remind people of the spectator policy and other rules.

He encouraged all to refrain from unsportsmanlike and disrespectful actions during games. No profanity or loud

negative comments toward athletes, opponents coaches or officials is allowed. All other school rules are also in effect.

He asks that no one talk to coaches with concerns after a game and instead set up a time with them the next school day to discuss them. They can only discuss the parents child with them.

Athletes must also adhere to the District policies regarding social media, and encour-

age parents to discuss issues with coaches and not there.

During away games, athletes are to ride with the team unless there have been arrangements made with a coach 24 hours prior to the event. Athletes are required to ride home with an approved family member and emergencies are an exception.
